INTRODUCTION TO BRIDAL ALTERATIONS

Bridal gown alterations necessitate a great deal of expertise and experience in fitting, sewing and design due to the often complex and detailed construction of bridal gowns themselves. Each bridal dress requires an expert eye with ability to assess how best it should be fitted to the given individual and tailored to achieve the perfect fit whilst preserving the integrity of its design and construction. Additionally, each dress presents its own unique challenges with delicate fabrics and complex embellishments to name just a few. Furthermore, each bride has their own unique form and their own unique expectation of how they wish their dress to fit and feel on their big day; both of which must be carefully considered and respected when determining the best way to proceed with each individual bridal alteration journey. At every stage of fitting effective communication between fitter and bride is key to ensure that all expectations are met and the desired outcome achieved – a perfect fit.

UNDERSTANDING BRIDAL ALTERATION COSTS

The aforementioned is inevitably why bridal alteration costs can be considerable and are higher than those often associated with the tailoring of most everyday-wear garments. The exact cost for any given bridal alterations order will be largely dependent on the dress/garment itself (its construction, detailing, fabric etc.), the number of alterations needing to be made, the complexity of the work involved and the time needed to perform the adjustments. For example, dresses comprising multiple layers, extensive corsetry, lace hems and extensive beading will incur high alteration costs due to the additional time needed to complete the alterations.

After purchasing your bridal gown, you may be eager at this early stage to determine an exact cost for your bridal alterations to help with wedding budget planning. However, all wedding dresses are different, as can be the alterations and the individual bride's requirements. As such, whilst we are more than happy to initially advise over email, as best we can, we are unable to provide an accurate quote until we have seen your dress in person, discussed things with you, determined the exact nature of the alterations and assessed exactly what will be involved in completing the adjustments for you. With this in mind, we advise that you contact the studio as soon as you have purchased your dress to book a consultation. This initial consultation is free of charge and you will be given a tailored quote for your bridal alterations. You are under no obligation to proceed with your order at this stage.

Our prices are calculated based on an hourly studio rate intended to cover all business overheads and to ensure that a fair wage is paid and representative of the quality of service, level of skill and expertise received throughout the process. With this in mind, we do not offer a cap on bridal alterations – to do so would be unethical and promote exploitative work practices. Each order is priced individually based on the exact nature of the work involved and any related materials that may be required.

The prices detailed below are given as a guide for bridal alteration labour costs and are inclusive of administrative time, fitting time and sewing time. Please note that all prices indicated are exclusive of material and notion costs. Please also note that for orders exceeding £350.00 a complimentary dress steaming is provided upon completion of your order.

* Based on shortening/levelling front skirt only and blending into existing train shape – please note that shortening and/or re-shaping the train/back skirt will require additional time and will thus incur higher alteration costs to facilitate.

** On occasion it may be possible to "let-out" or up-size a dress (typically up to two dress sizes depending on the style and construction) however, this is dependent on the design, exact nature of the up-sizing required and the seam quality and seam allowance present. Please note that, due to the often delicate nature of bridal and evening wear fabric and the likelihood that up-sizing may expose needle marks and colour variances, we do not advise or encourage upsizing wherever possible. As such, prices for this type of bridal alteration work have not been included in this pricing guide and we would strongly advise that you contact the studio as soon as possible and make an appointment to discuss the nature of your alterations, their feasibility and likely costings.

*** Please note, that the prices indicated here are for bodice suppression only; i.e., from the over bust, bust and finishing at the waist line. Alterations which are considerable in nature and require the dress to be completely down-sized and thus the skirt adjusted too will require additional time and will thus incur higher alteration costs due to their complexity.
